Pupil's Social Skills

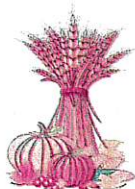

Morning Arrival at School

Could we please ask parents/carers to leave the playground area promptly in the morning, so that we can lock the gates, which is a Safeguarding issue to ensure that pupils are kept safe.

If you arrive at school late in the morning, please enter through the Main School Entrance area and ensure that one of the Office staff are informed that your child has arrived in school.

Aldi Vouchers

You may be aware that Aldi are now giving out Team GB stickers with Their Kit for Schools scheme. We will be collecting these stickers and if we manage to collect 300 the school will receive a sports kit plus a chance to win £20,000.

End of the school day

Could we please remind you that the school day ends at 3.15pm and that the children do need to be collected on time from their classrooms.

Parking outside the school

We are increasingly concerned about dangerous parking and driving outside the school both before and after school.

Cars are being abandoned partially on the grass verge on the other side of Henry Lane, which has recently caused a complete blockage when traffic was unable to pass. Please remember that the Fire Station is just down the road and fire engines **MUST** be able to safely pass through any parked vehicles, for the safety of our village community.

If you live too far away from school to walk, the Village Hall Committee has kindly agreed that cars can be parked in their car park whilst you then walk down to school to drop-off/collect your child.

Also please do not park on the double yellow lines around the vehicle entrance to the school grounds, as we need to keep this totally clear in case emergency vehicles need to enter at any time.

Heaven forbid, but it just feels like a matter of time before we have a serious incident outside school between a child/adult and a vehicle, which we desperately don't want.
