Please create a minimum of 4 pieces of work focussing on our topic. Remember this work can be art, Literacy, research, baking, whatever you are inspired to create!

I would love to see what creative ideas you can come up with to explore and deepen your understanding of the Maya civilisation, and therefore there are NO rules as to what you can create.

But if you need a bit of inspiration here are a few ideas:

- Can you bake/cook some Maya inspired food?
- Can you research an element of Maya society? (Food, clothing, hobbies etc.)
- Research a Maya God and present your findings as a poster.
- Can you create a news report as if you are reporting live from a archaeological dig? (You can write or video this.)
- Can you use paint to create an abstract piece of art reflecting the Maya society?
- Can you research Maya inventions and present your findings through art, a poster or a piece of writing?
- Can you write a diary as a Maya child?
- Can you research where the Maya people lived and create a PowerPoint showing your findings?
- Can you make or design a piece of Maya clothing?
- Can you create a model of a famous Maya monument?
- Can you write a piece of poetry about the Maya people?
