Our topic for this term is Our Community. Below is a brief description of what we have planned for this half term and how it relates to the Early Years Curriculum



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be building relationships and taking turns by playing games in small groups.

Physical Development

We will continue to provide lots of opportunities to develop gross and fine motor skills, both indoors and out. We use the hall everyday and have PE on Wednesday mornings with Mr Rose from Synergy Sports



Communication and Language – we will be learning new vocabulary related to our topic. We will take part in listening walks within the school grounds. We are continuing to look at initial sounds and recognising letters.

Understanding the world: We will be talking about where we live, who we live with, our school, occupations and people who help us. We will look at the celebrations of Shrove Tuesday, St David's Day, Mother's Day and Easter.

Maths - so much maths is built into our daily routine. In adult led maths activities we are looking at positional language and recording numbers using marks that we can interpret.

Literacy –building on our interest in books, looking at signs in the environment and writing for a purpose – including making shopping lists, writing menus and creating maps

Expressive Arts and Design: we will be junk modelling to build our own houses and creating our own representations of daffodils using paint.

Reminders: please label everything with your child's name. Please remember to bring coats etc. as we play outside in all weathers. It may also be useful to bring wellies. Thank you
